

## Middlesex County Police Agencies Enhance Public Safety With Help From AT&T

Middlesex County has chosen AT&T to provide innovative managed software that connects regional law enforcement and other officials to a central information database designed to enhance public safety and assist in crime-fighting. The contract includes the initial software purchase and a three-year maintenance agreement. Terms of the deal were not disclosed.

AT&T will work with Enforsys, a leading provider of law enforcement software and data services to provide the total package. AT&T will implement and maintain the solution, which links all municipal police departments within the County, the Middlesex County Sheriff's Office and the County Prosecutor to a database of searchable incident reports and other tools that validate or assist in the criminal investigations.

In addition to linking police officers and other local officials countywide, the software offers information services, alerts and analytical reporting for all crimes and incidents entered into the database. For example, if an officer logs a crime into the system with a repeat offender, it will alert the Prosecutor and Sheriff's Office and allow networked individuals to search for the criminal's prior offenses on the database, regardless of which officer or branch logged the former incidents.

"The integrated system will make police work more efficient and, in turn, help keep our residents safer," said Middlesex County Freeholder Director David B. Crabiel.

"This shared data is an incredible tool for our law enforcement personnel because it reaches across jurisdictions and geographic boundaries," said Freeholder Christopher D. Rafano, chair of the Middlesex County Law and Public Safety Committee. "This network integration package greatly enhances every participant's knowledge of criminal activity on a countywide basis and may help them see patterns or trends in criminal activity that they could use to prevent crime."
